Refreshing your pine needles and mulch now will give you immediate curb appeal. I do also recommend a good ornamental tree & shrub feeding in conjunction with a dormant oil treatment.



CRAPE MYRTLE PRUNING

January is the perfect time great time to prune crape myrtle(s)! It is best to prune crape myrtles during the winter months as the cold temperatures set-in this month. Pruning not only removes dead or weak branches, it also improves the appearance. In addition, pruning encourages new growth as well as controlling the size of your crapes. It is also a great time to prune back all your shrubs that need to be re-shaped or have overgrown during the past fall season. Call now to schedule your pruning.

EARLY SPRING TREATMENT

Now is the time to be thinking about what you lawn will need for the new upcoming year. It is imperative to be pro-active on providing your lawn with the necessary nutrients to feed the lawn, as well as, provide a preventative weed control. We use pre-emergent herbicide to help prevent weeds from germinating during our Early Spring Treatment. This should be applied the end of January into February. If you are a QCLL fertilization customer you will automatically receive this most beneficial treatment. However, if you have not signed up for this treatment, please call our office immediately.
